

5.2 Environmental Policy

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A Obligations

Prebuilt recognises its responsibility to protect the environment. Complying with legislative and regulatory requirements as a minimum standard. Operating in compliance to ISO 14001.

- Developing a framework for setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets

- Being committed to continual improvement and prevention of pollution.
- Specifying the use of materials that are safe and where possible, specifying the use of materials that are recycled, have low embodied energy and have a reduced impact on resource depletion.
- Engaging with our clients to identify, and seek to address their needs and concerns.
- Providing our employees with the information, training and support necessary to meet our environmental performance objectives.
- Working with our suppliers to ensure they understand, commit to and meet our standards for environmental management.
- Encouraging environmentally responsible products by working with our clients and educating them in their selections of building products.
